BCBH Prevention (Kenzie) – updated website (contact info, videos, etc), Youth underage substance use

Youth led philanthropy group (Jennifer) – Civic action, community service, grant writing (mental health grant), have about 20 on council, trying to expand through butte county, always looking for more people to join the crew, always looking for community service events, jserrano@buttecounty.net

Justin Moore – Narcan distribution, work with butte county, trying to strengthen and get the word out, Orchard hospital in Gridley, distributed to 8400 kits

Sanna – CADC conference in DC, similar efforts in Virginia, reached out to students to get them involved in naloxone, offer many trainings in person and online, offer many trainings in person, prevention and law enforcement session

Baylee Martin – Pharmacy at medical center has a drug drop off zone – open 7 days a week – for drug clean outs – walk in through main door, turn left, don't have to talk to anyone, pharmacists are trying to offer resources for people taking medication, you can go as any patient, do one on one counseling – great resources

Nathan Swetz – They are partnering with Medibag – do advertisement for pharmacy bags for prescriptions (48 different locations in Cali), info on drug addiction and overdose as well as numbers to call, 9 other patient navigators for ageist – they can be directly called for any questions, almost a million bags to be printed, finished Xylazine brochures and testing strips, letting parents know the drug is here and needs to be recognized and delt with safely. Xylazine is an animal tranquilizer – bad, eats away flesh when ingested in humans, prolongs effects of fentanyl, does not respond to Narcan

Kenzie – just hired part time staff to do opioid education, contact with schools in butte county, reach out if you want to get youth engaged and educated

Stonewall- working with north valley harm reduction, doing cross education and giving Narcan to places they do trainings at
