RISK FACTORS VS PROTECTIVE FACTORS



- Family history of substance use
- Favorable parental attitudes toward the behavior
- Poor parental monitoring
- Parental substance use
- Family rejection of sexual orientation or gender identity
- Association with delinquent or substance-using peers
- Lack of school connectedness
- Low academic achievement
- Childhood sexual abuse
- Mental health issues



PROTECTIVE Factors

- Self-efficacy
- Parental monitoring and support
- Parental disapproval of substance use
- Positive relationships
- Good grades
- School anti-drug policies
- Neighborhood resources
- School connectedness
- Engagement in healthy recreational activities
- Good coping skills

Knowledge of Parenting and Child Development

Understanding child development and parenting strategies that support physical, cognitive language, social and emotional development.

Social Connections

Having positive relationships that offer emotional, informational, instrumental and spiritual support.

Concrete Supports in Times of Need

Having access to tangible goods and services to help address family's needs and minimize stress.

Protective Factors

uild Family Strengths and Promote Optimal Child Development



Children's Social & Emotional Competence

Having family and child interactions that help children develop the ability to communicate clearly, recognize and regulate emotions and establish relationships.


