BUTTE GLENN MEDICAL SOCIETY SCHOLARSHIPS

Butte-Glenn Medical Society physician leaders know that the road to medical school, residency and then starting to practice medicine is long and difficult. Butte Glenn Medical Society provides scholarships to inspire the next generation of physicians to address access to healthcare in the local region. High school seniors from Butte and Glenn County are welcome to apply for the high school scholarship. Pre-Med program senior students at CSU Chico will also be eligible to apply for the college scholarship.

Beginning in Glenn County, and in collaboration with Glenn 2 Greatness, Healthy Rural California is launching MedEd Clubs in participating high schools. HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONS PATHWAYS PROGRAM

Healthy Rural California was awarded a grant in 2022 to recruit and support students from underrepresented regions and backgrounds pursue interests in medicine and nursing.

High School Seniors, Undergraduate Students, Nursing and Medical Students, and Medical Residents completing a rotation in Butte, Glenn, Shasta, and Tehama counties may apply to be part of the program, which includes:

- Stipend of \$4,250 upon completion of the eight-week internship / summer enrichment program
- Qualitative structured cohort programming (enrichment, career, summer internship, graduate school/medical school preparation)
- Financial and funding education workshops
- Newsletters, web based and social media support
- Research and community experiences
- Mental health awareness and support
- Mentoring opportunities with peers and healthcare professionals from diverse backgrounds
- Academic counseling/academic preparation skills
- Online educational component
